

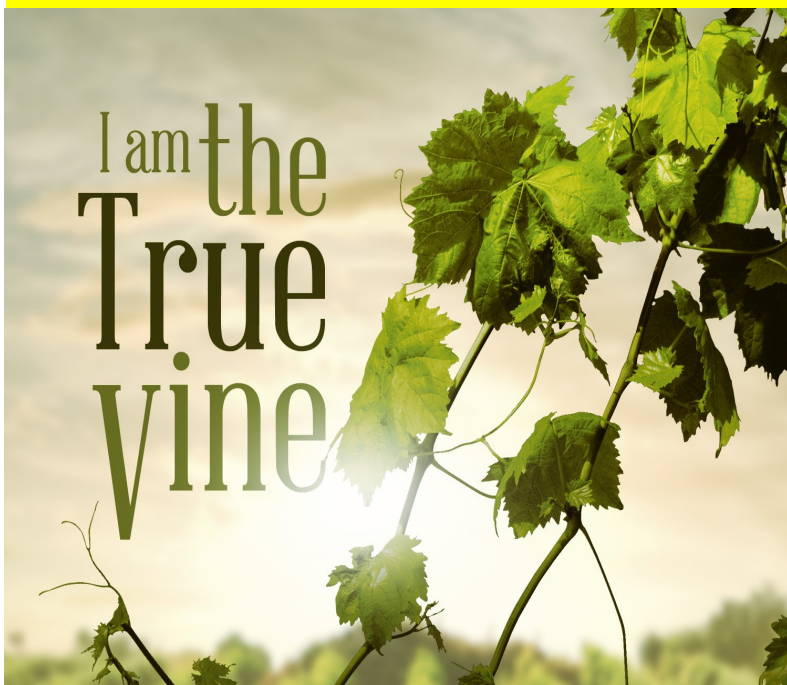

Fifth Sunday of Easter



The Lord nurtures us in love. Let us bring our prayers before him, trusting that his love is all we need.

When we remain in Jesus, his word remains in us, and we bear the fruit of love for one another. The Father prunes us, knowing what we need and do not need to grow and flourish. No other vine is as life-giving as that of Jesus.

In the first reading, Barnabas introduces Saul to the Apostles in Jerusalem. In the second reading, John teaches that we remain in Jesus by keeping his commandment to love one another. In the Gospel, Jesus is the true vine, we remain in him as he branches, and his Father is the vine grower pruning us to bear much fruit.
