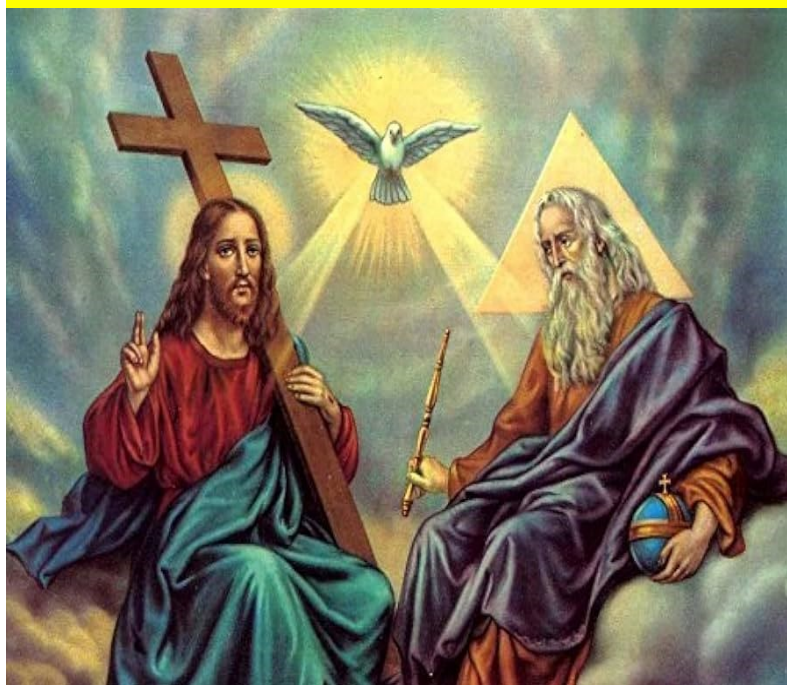

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity



Through Baptism we receive our identity as children of God with Christ.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is central to our Christian faith. We are baptized in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, receiving the Spirit that enables us to call God our Father. Our identity as sons and daughters of God calls us to share in the Son's suffering so that we might also share in his glory.

Moses tells the people that his actions of God on their behalf show he is Lord of heaven and earth. Paul tells the Romans that they have received a *Spirit of adoption* to be children of God and *joint heirs* with Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the eleven disciples to make disciples of all nations, *baptizing them in the name of the father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.*
