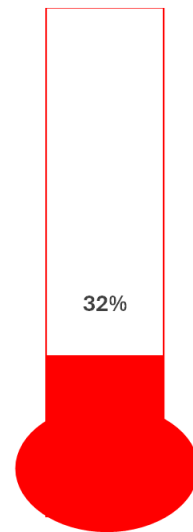

### 2024 St Jean the Baptiste Parish Projected Budget

**GOAL: \$ 207,273**

From Jan 1 until Apr 31 2024, we have collected \$65,731 of our goal of \$207,273 for the year.



In order to reach our goal, we need an average monthly collection of \$17,273 or 8.3% of our total goal.

For the first four months of 2024, we have collected an average of \$16,433 per month
