

The Lord expected that his people would obey his commands and follow his guidance... except they often didn't, notice who fails in this relationship: it's not God! God provided daily bread to sustain them in the desert. He provides for us the true bread of life-Jesus—to sustain us for eternity. The Lord never fails us, providing for our every need.

In the first reading, God feeds his people bread from heaven to sustain them in the desert. Paul exhorts the Ephesians to put on their new selves in Christ. In the Gospel, a few versus after feeding the crowd loaves and fishes, Jesus shared God's offer of true bread that endures for eternal life, that is, Jesus himself.
