#### **Pope's Prayer Intentions For January**


For the right to an education— - Let us pray for migrants, refuges, and those affected by war, that their right to an education, which is necessary to build a better world, might always be respected.

The Chosen Season 3 will begin starting January 8th 2025 at 7:00 pm in the rectory Basement.


# **Knights of Columbus Christmas Hampers**


