# The Lord is kind and merciful.

Today's psalm is a joyful song of thanksgiving and remembrance. We know the history of Moses' role in God delivering the Israelites from bondage, and we have heard the story of the baren fig tree, but the psalm allows us that moment of connection to God in our own particular way. He has pardoned us, he has healed us, he redeems us from destruction; he is merciful and gracious and surpassing in kindness. Our story is not just what happened then, but what is happening now, and the Lord indeed is kind and merciful.

In the first reading, Moses encounters God in a bush, and is commissioned by God to free the Israelites from Egypt. God reveals his name to Moses, saying, *I am who am*. In the second reading, Paul warns the Corinthians against overconfidence by recounting the story of the Israelites. In the Gospel, Jesus calls for repentance and tells a parable of a barren fig tree.
