Fifth Sunday Of Lent



Go, and from now on do not sin any more.

In this Lenten season, our readings reflect on mercy and repentance. Indeed, repentance is at the foundation of our Lenten calling. May we truly examine our hearts for ways we can seek God's abundant mercy and grow in our relationship with him. Like the woman caught in adultery, we must be willing to allow Jesus to see our shortcomings. If we wish to receive the forgiveness he offers.

In the first reading, the Lord recounts his marvelous deeds of the past, but points forward to something new. In the second reading, Paul looks to continue his pursuit of hope, rooted in the supreme good of knowing Christ Jesus. In the Gospel, Jesus is presented with a woman who was caught in adultery. Rather than recommend her stoning, Jesus asks the crowd to consider their own sin first.

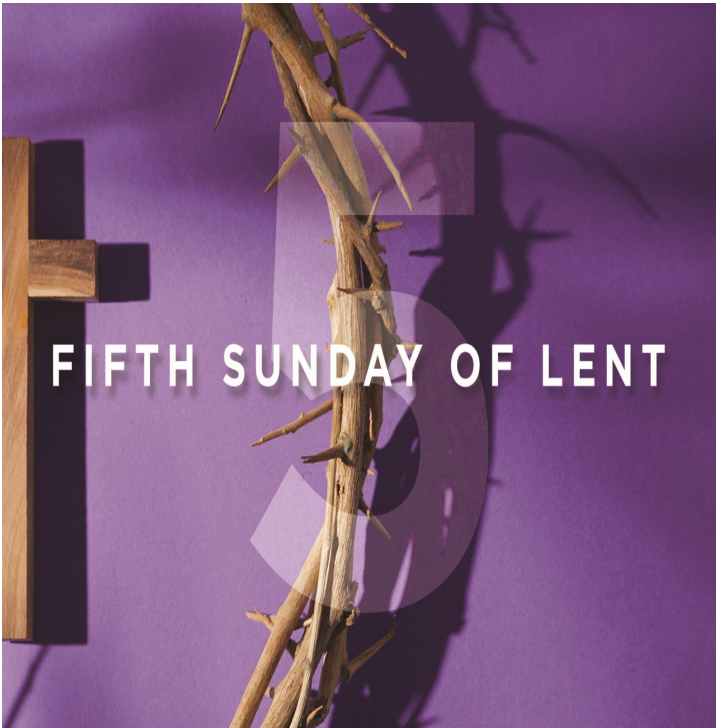
