World Communications Day June 1

Today Catholics are invited to reflect upon the media of social communication (films, radio, television, newspapers, audiovisuals) and how these influence our lives.

The media can promote values that lead to a more fully human society. The Church's ministry is twofold. The media can be used to help promote the Gospel. At the same time, as receivers of the materials presented by the media, the faithful have a duty to support and promote worthwhile presentations on media.

May we be Christ's joyful witnesses to the ends of the earth.

On this Solemnity of the Ascension, we recall with praise what Jesus has done for us by his suffering, death, and resurrection. We are called to not to simply meditate on these events, but to bring the fruits of our prayer into the world as his *witnesses*. This is the task of the Church—to preach the Gospel to *all nations*—and we participate in this individually by living and proclaiming our faith within our own spheres of influence.

In the first reading, the author tells Theophilius that is his first book he *dealt with all that Jesus was taken up from (them) into heaven*. In the second reading, Paul greets the Ephesians, blesses them and offers a prayer that they might have knowledge of Christ and the hope he offers. In the Gospel, Jesus ascends to heaven before the disciples. They return to Jerusalem with great joy, praising God.

Next Knights meeting will be on Tuesday June 17th at 7 pm at the Rendez-Vous centre.


Next breakfast will be **June 22nd** . From 9am—12 pm at the Rendezvous.
